



## Journal of Territorial and Maritime Studies Editorial Board Standards

This document was created in the interest of clearly expressing the terms and expectations for editorial board members of the Journal of Territorial and Maritime Studies. Our esteemed editorial board members join the JTMS editorial board with the understanding of the following.

### 1. Term

JTMS editorial board members shall serve a term of 3 years. Should the board member be interested in continuing to serve as an editorial board member, this may be extended depending on JTMS' assessment of the board member's contribution during their term.

### 2. Expectations

JTMS is a growing journal and our editorial board members are asked to contribute to our growth in whatever way they can. JTMS board members should actively provide guidance and contribute to the improvement of JTMS as an academic journal. For example, we welcome special issue suggestions, correspondence with ideas for improvement, and the like. JTMS expects editorial board members to correspond with the editorial staff and reply to correspondences in due time.

### 3. Editorial Board Member Roles

Editorial Board members shall:

- a. Assist the managing editor by occasionally providing peer review of manuscripts that suit their expertise in the field.
- b. Contribute one submission, either essay or research paper, during their 3 year term.
- c. Assist in disseminating calls for papers and other JTMS announcements through their respective academic networks.
- d. Approaching scholars regarding contributing their work to JTMS
- e. Endorse the journal to authors, readers and subscribers and encourage colleagues to submit their best work.
- f. Recommend suitable editorial board members
